The TCU Student Foundation is a select group of students dedicated to serving TCU. Sponsored by the Alumni Relations Office, members serve as ambassadors of TCU through a number of activities and functions. Among those activities are Monday at TCU programs, campus tours, alumni receptions and programs, Homecoming, annual fund thank-you calling, class gift programs and other projects as assigned.

REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANTS

- 1. All current freshmen, sophomores, and juniors are eligible to apply. Applicants must be able to serve for at least one school year (spring **and** fall semesters).
- 2. The applicant must have a 2.75 GPA or above if you are a current sophomore or junior. Freshmen must maintain a 2.75 GPA to remain in the organization.

TO APPLY

- 2. Recommendation One recommendation from TCU faculty or staff member is required. Recommendation should be made by an individual who is familiar with your personal qualities as well as your academic performance.
- 3. The application and recommendation must be submitted in hard copy to <u>one</u> of the following:
